HAROPA PORT has **connections to every continent** based on an international shipping offering in the first rank (in the top 20 of the world's most connected ports). It serves an extensive hinterland whose heart is along the Seine Valley and the Paris area, which together form the biggest consumer market in France and the second biggest in Europe, with 25 million consumers.

Today, HAROPA PORT is **France's number 1 logistics hub**, offering an end-to-end, holistic and decarbonised range of services.

From Le Havre to Paris, the port complex possesses a total of over16,000 hectares of area and 12 million sq. m. of warehousing space available along the Seine Axis.

Its annual maritime and river activity stands at 106m tonnes, generating €7.3m in value along with160,000 jobs. HAROPA PORT's ambitions
