

Gennevilliers

Located on a 401 hectares site, the Gennevilliers multimodal platform is**strategically situated in the Paris region**, at the heart of economic activity between La Défense and Paris-Charles de Gaulle Airport. It has a **container terminal** with a surface area of 26 hectares, operated by **Paris Terminal**.

It serves the following activities:

- · container,
- · heavy-lift,
- OOG.

Gennevilliers is also the terminus for oil pipelines from the Lower Seine and the connection point with the ring road networks around Paris (TRAPIL network).

The platform also has **three shared-use quays**; <u>le QUAI POMPIERS (quai bas)</u>, <u>le C40 Quai Haut</u> and <u>le QPS (quai haut)</u> which is specifically dedicated to **heavy-lift** and **OOG**.
