



Terminal de Gennevilliers

Located on a 401 hectares site, the Gennevilliers multimodal platform is **strategically situated in the Paris region**, at the heart of economic activity between La Défense and Paris-Charles de Gaulle Airport. It has a **container terminal** with a surface area of 26 hectares, operated by **Paris Terminal**.

It serves the **following activities**:

- **container,**
- **heavy-lift,**
- **OOG,**
- **dry bluk.**

Gennevilliers is also the terminus for oil pipelines from the Lower Seine and the connection point with the ring road networks around Paris (TRAPIL network).

The platform also has **three shared-use quays**; le QUAI POMPIERS (quai bas), le C40 Quai Haut and le QPS (quai haut) which is specifically dedicated to **heavy-lift** and **OOG**.
