

The Fécamp gravity-based foundations rise sail away

Friday, July 29, the Fécamp offshore wind farm entered a new phase. The first convoy carrying the first three gravity-based foundations left the port of Le Havre.

It was on the **Castoro XI pontoon** that the first three gravity-based foundations reached the future Fécamp offshore wind farm. **Assisted by three tugs**, this huge convoy firstly jumped over the François 1^{er} lock before to sail away on Saturday July 30 at the end of the day.

A total of **71 gravity-based foundations** will gradually leave the Bougainville terminal to reach their future immersion site.
