Friday, July 29, the Fécamp offshore wind farm entered a new phase. The first convoy carrying the first three gravity-based foundations left the port of Le Havre.

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It was on the **Castoro XI** pontoon that the first three gravity-based foundations reached the future **Fécamp offshore wind farm**. Assisted by three tugs, this huge convoy firstly jumped over the François 1er lock before to sail away on Saturday July 30 at the end of the day.

A total of 71 gravity-based foundations will gradually leave the Bougainville terminal to reach their future immersion site.
