SEAFRIGO GROUP STARTS CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW FROZEN FOODS LOGISTICS PLATFORM IN LE HAVRE'S PORT AREA

In partnership with HAROPA PORT, Seafrigo Group is continuing to develop and is starting construction of a new 13,000 sq. m. facility located in Le Havre's port area.

The new building will be dedicated to frozen food flows for super- and hypermarkets and agrifood manufacturers. It will be capable of handling 35,000 pallets and equipped with Very Narrow Aisle (VNA) trucks to optimise productivity when handling loads.

Environmental testing has been completed and construction will begin before the end of the second quarter of 2023 with a view to commissioning in the last quarter of 2024.

The new facility is a substantial investment for the Group at the port of Le Havre and will lead to the creation of numerous jobs.

Since 1 June 2021, the ports of Le Havre, Rouen and Paris form the "major Seine Axis river and sea port authority". As the fourth largest north-European port, HAROPA PORT has connections to every continent based on an international maritime offering in the very first rank (calling at nearly 620 ports). It serves an extensive hinterland centred on the Seine Valley and the Paris region, together constituting France's biggest consumer catchment area. From Le Havre to Paris, the port complex can point 2.5m sq. m. of logistics warehousing currently in service and over 1m sq. m. of available warehousing space.
