

Best Green Seaport 2022: Asian customers declare HAROPA PORT the winner for the 6th time



HAROPA PORT has been awarded the Best Green Seaport prize

at the AFLAS awards ceremony on 7 September last in Hong Kong, winning against the ports of Hamburg, Long Beach and Singapore, its competitors in the final round of voting.



This prize comes as an illustration of the recognition of HAROPA PORT's environmental policy and its strong commitment to reducing the ecological cost of our activities.

The prize was awarded following voting by the 15,000-strong Asian readership of the trade magazine Asia Cargo News. Candidate ports were shortlisted on the basis of the following criteria:

- ▶ **Compliance with the environmental standards** applicable to goods transports
- ▶ **Investments** in green initiatives
- ▶ **Consideration of environmental requirements** in strategic planning
- ▶ **A policy of fuel emissions reduction** during stevedoring operations
- ▶ **Continuous training** of staff on measures designed to reduce the carbon footprint
