New regular heavy goods service between the port of Gron and HAROPA PORT



LogiYonne started a freight service for heavy cargo at the end of 2021

departing Gron river port in Burgundy-Franche-Comté, destinations Rouen and Le Havre.

LogiYonne, a company responsible for the development and operation of Gron Port, is now the owner of the Exelmans, a vessel to be shortly renamed the Burgundy as a tribute to its region of origin. A one million euro investment that launches LogiYonne as a river shipowner.

A vessel suited to navigation on the Yonne and Seine


Can be ballasted to pass under all bridges
