NOVA MET signaled the start-up in January of its activities

for production of aluminium from recycling, signing a land use agreement with HAROPA PORT. The company had the benefit of support from the Le Havre Seine development agency.

## Characteristics of the new NOVA MET facility



▶20,000 sq. m. in area



► 2,500 tonnes of aluminium processed each month



►15 direct jobs created in the Le Havre employment area



► 80 containers per month exported to South Asia by 2023

▶▶ By choosing Le Havre as the location for its second production facility, NOVA MET is setting out to take advantage of its strategic positioning in the port area to underpin its outreach to international markets, especially in Asia and Europe.
