- Equipment accepted: all Dry containers including 45' HCPW / Reefer 45' / Shipper Owned
- Transit times: Bilbao - Le Havre: 36h / Le Havre - Dublin: 24h

This shipping service is complemented by several rail connections to the Spanish and British hinterlands:

- from Bilbao: services to Madrid - Zaragoza - Barcelona - Valencia - La Rioja (Agoncillo)
- from Liverpool: service to Mossend (Scotland)

Maritime transshipment connections are also available from Bilbao to the Canaries, Portugal and Morocco.
