

## Inaugural call of the 'HMM OSLO', a giant of the seas in Le Havre

► On Tuesday, June 30, HAROPA welcomed one of the largest and newest containerships in the world. A new capacity record for the port of Le Havre!

During its inaugural voyage, the mega containership HMM Oslo of the Korean shipping line HMM, made a call at the Port of Le Havre. HMM Oslo is assigned to the service operated as part of the THE Alliance consortium (HMM, Hapag, Lloyd, ONE and Yang Ming) on the Asia-Europe FE2 service.

### HMM Oslo, a giant of the seas

- Vessel type megamax 24 (24 bays and 24 rows)
- 400 meters long
- 61.50 meters wide
- Capacity of 23,792 TEUs
- Maximum draught of 16.50 meters



### HAROPA – Port of Le Havre, exceptional nautical conditions

Deep water-port, it is the only port in Europe along with Rotterdam, with the capacity to receive the largest containerships in the world **at full load and without tidal constraints**.
